**ARCHERY** – Learn bow safety, selection, shooting stance, and shooting techniques.

**ATV OPERATIONS** – “Know Before You GO!” Learn basic riding skills, laws, responsibilities, proper usage of safety equipment and more!

**BIRD WATCHING** – Learn about the different birds in our area. There are over 100 different species in Tooele County alone! Our instructor has traveled all over the world and taken some amazing bird photos. In addition, she recently spotted a rare White Raven near Dugway. If you like birds, you’ll love this class!

**CANOEING:** Participants will travel to Grantsville Reservoir where they will learn how to paddle a canoe and more importantly, learn how to avoid tipping over!

**CAR MECHANICS** – Learn to change a tire. Also learn to change your own oil, antifreeze and brake, wiper and transmission fluids. You will learn how to jump start a dead battery and much, much more!

**CRAFT WOOD CLASS** – Learn to make gifts from wood. Two unique projects will be taught in this class.

**CONCEALED WEAPON:** Work on becoming certified to carry a concealed weapon. We suggest that you take “handguns” prior to taking this class. (*Cost here is only \$50.00 in addition to a nominal fee for the required back ground checks.*)

**DREAM CATCHERS:** Learn how to make dream catchers.

**DUTCH OVEN COOKING:** Learn the art of cooking, achieving the correct temperatures, & how to properly care for your Dutch oven(s).

**FLY-FISHING:** Learn the techniques of basic fly casting, fly fishing terminology and selecting the proper equipment.

**FLY-TYING:** Learn to tie your own flies that you can take with you to your favorite lake or stream!

**GPS:** Learn the basics of how to use a GPS. (Several popular cell phones styles now come equipped with GPS). It can save time and perhaps even your life by knowing how to use a GPS unit. You should never travel the backcountry without one!!!!

**HANDGUNS:** Learn handgun safety & what to look for when purchasing a handgun. You will also get to shoot!

**HIKE – HOOFIN’ IT:** Experience “fast-pace” hiking for some great exercise on some great trails!

**HIKE – NATURE WALKS:** Hiking at a more “laid-back” pace and learning the do’s and don’ts of hiking.

**KNOTS, ROPES & LASHINGS:** Learn the proper ropes and knots for outdoor activities.

**OUTDOOR NUTRITION:** Learn how to properly take care of your body so you can experience the great outdoors.

**RAPPELLING:** Conquer your fears and learn to maneuver down a mountain in a controlled manner with an experienced instructor. Due to travel time to Stockton, this is a 4-hour class. (\$8 fee also required).

**SCRAP BOOKING:** Create a home for those “woody” photos of your outdoor adventures.

**SELF DEFENSE:** Learn to protect or if necessary, defend yourself from an attacker. Learn to size up a situation and catch the attacker off guard (thereby developing a greater self-confidence in a potentially dangerous situation).

**SHOTGUNS:** Learn to properly use a shotgun while shooting clay pigeons.

**STICKS and STAFFS:** Learn how to make walking sticks and staffs.

**SURVIVAL:** Don’t be caught unprepared in a challenging situation. Learn outdoor survival skills that can save your life

**WATER AEROBICS:** Have a refreshing work out in our camp swimming pool. (Weather permitting)

**WRITING WORKSHOP:** Learn to write freely and creatively about your outdoor experiences
